ABOUT THE PROJECT

MOMENTUM Routine Immunization Transformation and Equity

The Government of India launched the world's largest COVID-19 vaccination program in 2021 to accelerate vaccination uptake among vulnerable and hard to reach populations in the country.

MOMENTUM Routine Immunization Transformation and Equity Project, supported by the United States Agency for International development(USAID), has mandated John Snow India Private Limited(JSIPL) to provide technical assistance to National and state governments to ramp up COVID-19 vaccination in India. Johan snow India Pvt. Ltd., an affiliate of JSI US, is working in close collaboration with the Government of India to strengthen their outreach and delivery efforts with communities for vaccination and through partnerships with local NGOs to increase demand, distribution and uptake of overall vaccination services, particularly for vulnerable and marginalized populations across selected 18 states and Union territories of India.

Information Dissemination

In Rajasthan, Ladli Foundation under MOMENTUM Routine Immunization Transformation and Equity project has started working in Jaipur, Dausa, Nagaur, Churu and Rajsamand districts. Various strategies were adopted to increase awareness and encourage people to get vaccinated. The initiative included door-to door campaigns and community meetings. The ladli team played a crucial role in increasing awareness and encourage overall vaccination services in the state of Rajasthan.

MAJOR PROPOSED ACTIVITIES

State Level Induction cum Orientation Meeting

The State Level Induction Cum Orientation Meeting was conducted by the Ladli Foundation Trust, which was convened on September 4, 2023 in which participants from Jaipur, Nagaur, and Dausa districts participated. State-level review meeting was organized for all the project team members from Ladli Foundation with the state JSI team. The main object of the meeting was to orient the team members and review the work under the guidance of JSI state team. The meeting, held at the Hotel Vesta International, marked a significant milestone in our commitment to improving routine immunization services and ensuring equitable access to these essential healthcare interventions.

Dr. Dheerendra Tyagi and Dr. R.P. Jain orient the team and showcased poignant videos spotlighting children afflicted by ailments such as diphtheria, Rota, and anaemia, further emphasizing the dire need for comprehensive vaccination programs. Further JSI M&E officer conducted a session on data analysis and reporting, emphasizing the importance of data-driven decision-making. At the end the target for every district was discussed.

CELEBRATION OF SPECIAL DAYS

Ladli ingeniously devised a distinctive approach to raise awareness among the general population about COVID-19 vaccination and Routine Immunization. This involved leveraging the celebratory spirit of festivals such as Dusshera, Eid, Diwali, and others. By integrating immunization messaging into these festive occasions, Ladli successfully motivated thousands of individuals to actively participate and enhance the demand for comprehensive immunization services. This innovative strategy not only capitalized on the joyous atmosphere of festivals but also effectively communicated the importance of vaccination, contributing to increased public engagement and uptake of immunization services across the state.



MULTI-FAITH BASED LEADER MEETING

A community mobilization initiative was implemented by convening leaders representing various faiths on a unified platform to amplify the advocacy for Routine Immunization. The primary focus of the gathering was to enlighten these leaders about the critical significance of Routine Immunization and encourage them to extend this awareness through their influential teachings within their respective communities.

This collaborative meeting proved to be highly successful, as all the faith-based leaders exhibited a commendable level of cooperation. Importantly, they willingly undertook the responsibility to enhance the demand for Routine Immunization in their communities by integrating the immunization message into their teachings. This demonstrated a strong commitment from the faith-based leaders to leverage their influential positions for the betterment of public health, thus fostering a broader understanding and acceptance of Routine Immunization within diverse communities.



SENSITIZING TRIBAL COMMUNITY

Operating in the culturally rich landscape of Rajasthan, Team under the project undertook the challenging task of sensitizing the tribal communities like Lohar community, Vanabagariya community, Jogi community, bhand basti etc. Recognizing the importance of cultural sensitivity, the team engaged in targeted counseling sessions and actively participated in the tribal community's cultural festivals. Overcoming the initial difficulty in reaching and sensitizing the tribes, team facilitated meaningful group discussions, fostering open dialogue. The foundation successfully organized vaccination camps specifically tailored for the tribal population, ensuring equitable access to healthcare services. By integrating into their cultural fabric, we not only addressed the challenges but also strengthened community bonds. This approach exemplifies Ladli's commitment to inclusivity and underscores the importance of culturally tailored strategies in effectively promoting routine immunization within diverse communities.



IPC ACTIVITY WITH SAPERA COMMUNITY

The kalbeliya, a snake charmer community from Rajasthan, performs Kalbeliya dance. They are renowned dancers, musicians and snake charmers and are identified as gypsies in modern India culture. Kalbeliya is a nomadic community who sometimes introduces themselves as saperas.

Ladli team has identified the community residing in Dausa, and mobilized and sensitized them about Routine Immunization through engagement activities and IPC sessions. The team organised special camps in their community for immunization of their children



NUKKAD NATAKS (STREET PLAY)

Team Ladli achieved a significant breakthrough with a compelling nukkad natak (street play) across slums in Dausa, Jaipur, Nagaur, Rajsamand, and Churu. Targeting communities, especially mothers, the innovative approach aimed at sensitizing them to routine immunization and child health. The activity was evident as they engaged thousands effectively, blending creativity with public health advocacy. The impactful storytelling and vibrant performances served as both entertainment and education on immunization. Remarkably, numerous community members and mothers pledged to prioritize their children's health through vaccination, showcasing the effectiveness of nukkad natak in fostering awareness and positive action in diverse communities.



SPECIAL BYJU'S VACCINATION CAMP

Vaccination for all Education for All

In all the implementing districts, BYJU's special vaccination camp was organized. Students aged between 15-17 and 10 - 16 were vaccinated and a free BYJU's premium subscription of three years was given to them after the vaccination. The school is identified where a number of students were unvaccinated due to vaccine hesitancy. To break the hesitancy and to motivate students to get vaccinated, a special camp was organized where students were given free BYJU's subscriptions for 3 years which became an important tool due to which students could be mobilized for vaccination effectively. This activity helped us to reach those students/parents who were against vaccination, and we could reach those students whose first vaccination dose was also not completed. The main goal of this activity is to increase the uptake of covid-19 vaccination and TD Vaccination among students by connecting them through digital learning. This activity was appreciated by the state authorities.



ROUTINE IMMUNIZATION TRAINING

A comprehensive training workshop was organized for state and district-level staff in the districts. The primary objective of this workshop is to provide orientation and enhance the understanding of the technical aspects of project related staff and other district health professionals in the implementing districts of MRITE on Routine Immunizations (RI). The district government officials along with community health workers, community workers/volunteers, local NGO's and other stakeholders participated in the training. The participants was also given UWIN training.



FELICITATION OF VACCINATORS

An admiration ceremony was arranged to honour the ANMs in Jaipur and Dausa districts for their exceptional dedication and assistance to the Ladli team in the crucial mission of routine immunization for children under 5. Recognizing their outstanding contributions, the event celebrated the pivotal role these healthcare professionals play in ensuring the well-being of young children. The ANMs' unwavering commitment and support have significantly contributed to the success of the immunization program, highlighting their crucial role in safeguarding the health of the community's youngest members.



Door to Door Awareness Generation

Team Ladli under the project conducts impactful door-to-door counseling sessions, sensitizing both rural and urban communities about overall vaccination services. Recognizing the challenges faced by women unable to leave their homes due to household responsibilities, Ladli initiates a focused awareness drive by going door-to-door with the Asha workers and ANMs. Through concise and engaging interactions, Ladli's doorstep counseling brings vital health information directly to those who may otherwise miss out. This proactive approach ensures that crucial health insights reach every doorstep, contributing to a healthier and more informed community.



Intervention in Kachi Basti and Hard-to-Reach areas

Our team launched tailored awareness and IPC initiatives in the distant Kachi Basti and hard-to-reach areas, where essential facilities and immunization awareness were lacking. Special vaccination camps were organized, extending vital healthcare access. Engaging in multiple counseling sessions, our efforts prioritized the most vulnerable populations within the Kachi Basti and remote areas, ensuring comprehensive outreach. Creative activities complemented our awareness drive, making health education accessible and engaging. This holistic approach addressed the unique challenges faced by people living in such difficult areas fostering a community-wide understanding of routine immunization and healthcare practices.



SPECIAL VACCINATION CAMPS

The special vaccination camp took place in the priority block of Dausa Jaipur and Nagaur. The initiative aimed to encourage the community and understand them about the important role of Routine Immunization in their children health. During this camp, members of the Jogia community utilized their musical instruments and presented specially curated songs and dances to raise awareness about routine immunization, street plays etc creative activities were performed to create awareness. Simultaneously, a vaccination camp was conducted to address children in the village who had not yet received vaccinations.



END OF PROJECT EVENT

The event was organised at a state level, in collaboration with government officials and other development partners. The purpose is to disseminate information about the project's contributions and efforts toward improving immunization services across states. Additionally, the event served as a platform to exchange good practices, discuss the strategies employed during the implementation of the M-RITE project, and highlight the achieved results. During the event approx 100 participants participated among which 21 medical officers of 21 urban PHC were also present.



BEST PRACTICES

- Identification of marginalized populations living in slums, laborer and daily wagers-based communities
- Door to door IPC sessions and outreach sessions within the community
- Increased the students TD vaccination by providing a free BYJUs premium subscriptions of 3 years
- Engaging frontline health workers, sarpanch, parents and multi-faith based gurus to spread awareness about RI and Covid-19 vaccination.
- Support from other development partners and local NGOs for camp planning and mobilization
- Public announcements to increase awareness and help in information dissemination for the COVID-19 vaccination and Routine Immunization in the community
- Mobilization of children from hard to reach areas/rural areas to nearest PHCs for vaccination
- Exclusively designed Nukkad Nataks and Ratri chaupals in High risk areas
- Fun and reward-based activities like dance, music, sports and painting competition to effectively engage students for COVID-19 vaccination and TD vaccination
- To create sustainable awareness, a variety of sensitization workshops and interactive sessions were organized.

ACHIEVEMENTS

- The organization could present the work to the President of India, Ms Droupadi Murmu in the president's house. The hon'ble President of India appreciated the work of the organization under this project.
- The organization received appreciation letters from CMHO and RCHO of the three district for the leadership and innovation in promoting routine immunization.
- Community Mobilization Activities, including launching IMI 5.0 with government officials, organizing Ratri Chaupal, showcasing folk dance, utilizing miking for effective communication
- Special Vaccination Camp was organized in all three districts in which team could Sensitize mass population and did outreach camps in the high risk areas.
- The organization was successful in conducting a Routine Immunization workshop with partners and relevant stakeholders. Along with district health departments, frontline healthcare providers participated in the meeting.
- BYJU'S special vaccination camp was organized in the districts. During the camps, the students get vaccinated and are equipped with a free BYJUs premium subscription for 3 years. Through these camps, the team was able to reach those students who were hesitant about COVID-19 vaccination and Tetanus and Diptheria vaccination.
- The team with the local health department did micro-planning in all the four districts which could help the health system to increase the mobilization of beneficiaries.
- The organization engaged spiritual leaders to burst the myths and taboos associated with Routine Immunization

CHALLENGES

- Parents are hesitant towards Routine Immunization of their children as there is a lot of misconception and misinformation towards vaccination.
- Certain religious, philosophical, or cultural beliefs conflict with the concept of vaccination.
- Insufficient knowledge about the benefits and importance of routine immunization has contributed to the low demand for vaccination.
- Elections in the state of Rajasthan, due to which the organization is not able to organize mass level activities
- Some minorities communities are hesitant to participate in immunization sessions.
