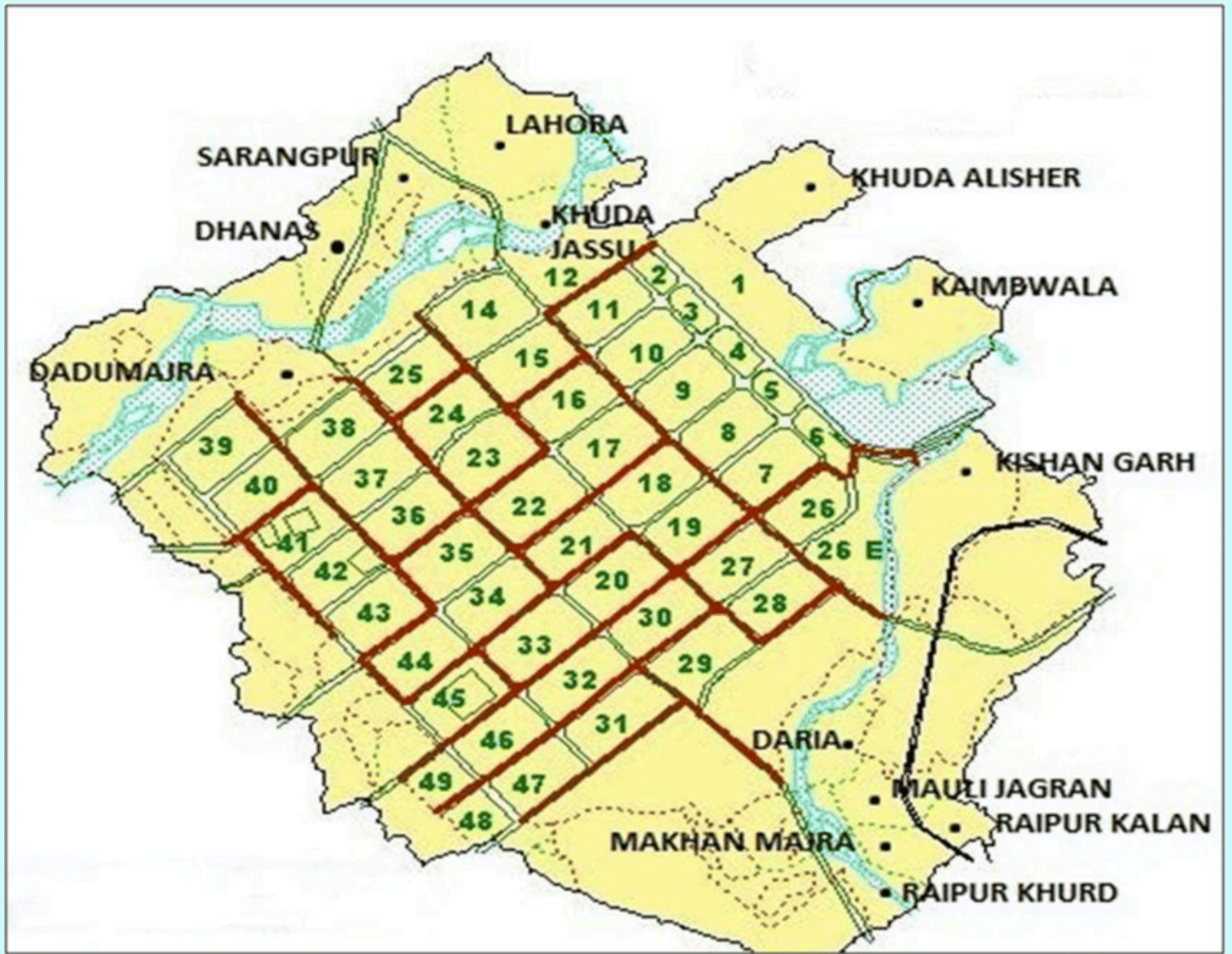

The Government of India launched the world's largest COVID-19 vaccination program in 2021 to accelerate vaccination uptake among vulnerable and hard to reach populations in the country.

MOMENTUM Routine Immunization Transformation and Equity Project, supported by the United States Agency for International development(USAID), has mandated John Snow India Private Limited(JSIPL) to provide technical assistance to National and state governments to ramp up COVID-19 vaccination in India. Johan snow India Pvt. Ltd., an affiliate of JSI US, is working in close collaboration with the Government of India to strengthen their outreach and delivery efforts with communities for vaccination and through partnerships with local NGOs to increase demand, distribution and uptake of overall vaccination services, particularly for vulnerable and marginalized populations across selected 18 states and Union territories of India.







Information Dissemination

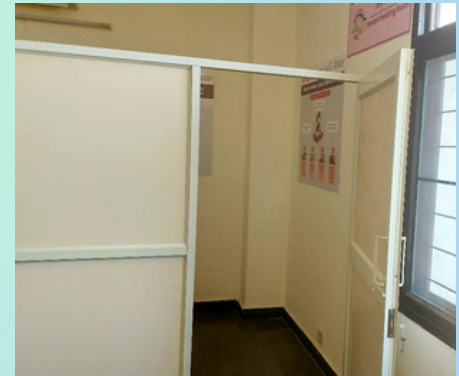


MODEL IMMUNIZATION CENTER

Maloya and Sec 45, Chandigarh

Key features include a dedicated play area for children, making the visit enjoyable and less stressful for young patients. Informative IEC displays are strategically placed to educate beneficiaries on the importance of immunizations and overall health. The center also boasts a well-demarcated layout, ensuring a smooth and efficient flow for visitors. A special breastfeeding room has been established to provide a private and comfortable space for mothers and their infants. This holistic approach not only supports child health but also empowers mothers by addressing their needs.

EVENING VACCINATION CAMPS

Special camps have been organized in the urban slums of Chandigarh and Jaipur targeting areas with a predominantly mobile population, such as daily wage workers and domestic laborers. Given their busy schedules during the day, these individuals are typically free only in the evening hours. Recognizing this, Ladli Foundation strategically planned evening vaccination camps with the support of various stakeholders. These camps successfully vaccinated children from these high-risk groups, including migrants and mobile populations. The initiative ensured that even those with challenging work schedules could access essential immunization services. By adapting the timing and location of the camps, the foundation effectively addressed the unique needs of these communities, enhancing the overall reach and impact of their health interventions. This approach not only improved vaccination rates but also demonstrated a deep understanding of the target population's lifestyle and constraints.



SENSITIZING IN HIGH RISK COMMUNITY

Sensitization programs and activities about routine immunization and child health are being organized in High Risk Areas (HRA) such as Katputli Nagar in Jaipur, Kalakar Basti clusters in Chandigarh, and urban slums. These initiatives aim to raise awareness about routine immunization and other critical health issues. To effectively reach these communities, a combination of faith-based activities and modern outreach methods, such as miking, is employed. Faith-based leaders play a crucial role in promoting the importance of immunization during religious events and gatherings. Concurrently, loudspeakers are used for miking to broadcast informative messages throughout the neighborhoods. These programs ensure that vital health information is disseminated widely, encouraging community participation and enhancing the uptake of immunization services. The strategic blend of cultural sensitivity and accessible communication methods significantly improves public health outcomes in these vulnerable areas.



NUKKAD NATAKS (STREET PLAY)

Team Ladli achieved a significant breakthrough with a compelling nukkad natak (street play) across slums in Jaipur, Chomu, and Chandigarh. Targeting communities, especially mothers, this innovative approach aimed to sensitize them to routine immunization and child health. The street play effectively engaged thousands, blending creativity with public health advocacy. Impactful storytelling and vibrant performances served as both entertainment and education on immunization. As a result, numerous community members, particularly mothers, pledged to prioritize their children's health through vaccination. This initiative showcased the effectiveness of nukkad natak in fostering awareness and positive action, highlighting its role in educating diverse communities about crucial health issues. Additionally, the street plays facilitated direct interaction between healthcare workers and the community, addressing specific concerns and misconceptions about immunization. The success of these performances underscored the power of culturally resonant methods in public health campaigns, significantly improving vaccination rates and community health awareness



RATRI CHOPAL

Ladli Foundation is making a significant impact by organizing Ratri Chopal for the labor class on weekends in Jaipur and Chandigarh. These sessions or chopals are held at night, recognizing the busy daytime schedules and reliance on daily wages of the laborers. Engaging the mobile population, we incorporate cultural shows and involve local leaders to enhance participation. Moreover, we captivate our beneficiaries with meaningful puppet shows and other creative and cultural programs. Through these initiatives, we effectively raise awareness on routine immunization, child health, contributing to the overall health and well-being of the labor class and their families.



FATHERS MEETING

Team Ladli organized meetings specifically for fathers in Jaipur and Chandigarh to educate them about the importance of vaccination and encourage their active participation in their children's immunization process. The sessions emphasized that fathers, alongside mothers, share the responsibility of ensuring their children receive complete vaccinations. Fathers were informed about the vaccination schedule and their crucial role in taking their children to immunization appointments. These meetings aimed to shift the perception that child health care is solely the mother's responsibility and to foster a more inclusive approach where both parents are actively involved. By providing detailed information on the benefits of vaccinations and addressing common concerns, we aimed to empower fathers with the knowledge needed to support their children's health effectively.



SENSITIZATION OF MINORITY COMMUNITY

Ladli Foundation conducted a sensitization program in Jaipur and Chandigarh aimed at educating and empowering mothers and adolescent girls from minority communities about routine immunization and vaccination. This initiative addressed prevalent myths and misconceptions surrounding vaccination, fostering a better understanding of its importance for child health. Through informative talks and counseling sessions, Ladli team members focused on debunking myths and providing accurate information to encourage acceptance and uptake of routine immunization. By empowering mothers and adolescent girls with knowledge, this program aimed to enhance vaccination awareness and promote proactive healthcare practices within minority communities. The event underscored the importance of community engagement and targeted education in addressing barriers to vaccination.



INNOVATIVE ACTIVITIES

SAMUHIK GOD BHARAI

In an innovative celebration, expecting mothers and their mother-in-laws gathered in Jaipur and Chandigarh for a Samuhik Gaudbharai. This event blended cultural traditions with a crucial health mission: promoting complete vaccination for children.

Expecting mothers pledged to ensure their children receive full vaccination, while mother-in-laws committed to supporting their daughters-in-law in routine immunization efforts for their grandchildren. This approach honored cultural beliefs and fostered a support network for new mothers. Local leaders and frontline workers, including Asha-ANM workers and Medical Officers in Charge (MOIC), actively participated, emphasizing the community's unified commitment to children's health. This Samuhik Gaudbharai successfully raised awareness about routine immunization, demonstrating how cultural practices can enhance public health initiatives.



SAMUHIK KUAN POOJAN

Ladli Foundation, through its effective community outreach, is enhancing Routine Immunization for mothers and newborns. Embracing traditional beliefs, the Foundation ensures no child is left without immunization by celebrating the unique Kuan Pujan ceremony in Jaipur, Rajasthan. This initiative is supported by frontline health workers and actively involves dai maas, who play a crucial role in community health. Through this ground-based effort, Ladli Foundation successfully bridges cultural traditions with essential health practices, ensuring a healthier future for every child.



DADA - DADI KI DUAYEN

Ladli Foundation has pioneered a unique community mobilization activity called #Dada_Dadi_ki_Duaye. Recognizing that grandparents hold the key to tradition and wisdom, this initiative empowers them to lead the charge in debunking myths around routine immunization. Through 'Dada Dadi ki Duaye,' grandparents are actively involved in promoting the importance of vaccination, ensuring their grandchildren receive the full spectrum of immunizations necessary for a healthy future. This initiative not only highlights the crucial role of elders in the community but also bridges generational gaps, fostering a unified front in the fight against preventable diseases. Ladli Foundation collaborates with frontline health workers and community leaders to provide accurate information and support. By leveraging the influence and respect that grandparents command, the program effectively mobilizes communities, raises awareness, and encourages the complete vaccination of all children. In essence, 'Dada Dadi ki Duaye' combines tradition with modern health practices, creating a powerful platform for ensuring the well-being of the next generation.



TRANSGENDER MEETING - BADHAI GROUP

Ladli Foundation is empowering the transgender community to raise awareness about routine immunization. With strong support from government stakeholders, this initiative aims to ensure every household in Jaipur and Chandigarh understands the importance of complete vaccination for children. By involving the transgender community, we leverage their unique influence to debunk myths and promote accurate information about immunization. This collaboration not only boosts public health efforts but also fosters inclusivity and empowerment for the transgender community. Through this innovative approach, Ladli Foundation and its partners are creating a more inclusive and health-conscious society, ensuring no child is left unprotected from preventable diseases.



SOCIAL INTERNSHIP - TEEKA MITRA

The Ladli Foundation launched its Social Internship Program in Rajasthan and Chandigarh, enrolling 1152 students from various educational institutions, both governmental and private. This initiative aims to deepen students' comprehension of Routine Immunization through a holistic approach encompassing extracurricular activities, field visits, specialized training, and self-directed learning. Its core objective is to raise awareness within society, empowering students through hands-on experiences and encouraging their participation in volunteer opportunities. By fostering an appreciation for grassroots realities and promoting sustainable solutions to routine immunization challenges, the program endeavors to create a lasting impact. Participants not only gain practical insights but also develop essential leadership qualities and a sense of empathy.



SAAS BAHU SAMMELAN

Ladli Foundation initiated a unique Saas Bahu Sammelan, uniting mothers-in-law and daughters-in-law to discuss the importance of Routine Immunization. This platform fosters open dialogue and mutual understanding, empowering both generations to prioritize complete vaccination for children. The Sammelan provides an opportunity to address concerns, share knowledge, and debunk myths related to immunization. By engaging both mothers-in-law and daughters-in-law, the initiative leverages familial bonds to strengthen commitment to children's health. Through this event, Ladli Foundation aims to spread awareness and ensure every child receives the necessary protection from preventable diseases. Together, we can create a community where every child is fully vaccinated and safeguarded for a healthy future.



SENSITIZATION OF MCD WORKERS

We have been sensitizing MCD workers in Jaipur and Chandigarh, conducting early morning sessions. Additionally, we organized workshops for groups of MCD sweepers and their families, focusing on routine immunization and the importance of vaccinations for child health. These interactive workshops included counseling sessions, encouraging active participation and dialogue from all attendees. These workshops have been instrumental in promoting complete vaccination of children in Jaipur and Chandigarh.



BAAL SABHA

Team Ladli has launched an impactful awareness initiative called "BAAL SABHA," immersing communities in creativity and compassion. This remarkable activity showcases the extraordinary talents of students through soulful singing, enchanting music, and heartfelt poetry, all highlighting the importance of routine immunization and its profound impact on child health. Organized in schools and slums, BAAL SABHA engages children actively, making them central to the awareness generation process. These sessions not only educate but also inspire, using artistic expression to convey critical health messages. By involving young voices, we foster a deeper understanding and commitment to immunization within the community. Through BAAL SABHA, Team Ladli effectively raises awareness and emphasizes the necessity of complete vaccination, ensuring every child receives the protection they deserve for a healthy future.



PARIVAR MAHOTSAV

Ladli Foundation initiated Parivar Mahotsav with a primary focus on empowering families with knowledge about routine immunization. Through inviting families to sit together and participate in discussions, our aim was to create a supportive environment conducive to sharing and understanding vaccination information. The event underscored the importance of timely immunization for children and highlighted the consequences of missing vaccinations. By ensuring entire families were aware of vaccination schedules and benefits, Parivar Mahotsav aimed to facilitate comprehensive immunization coverage. By empowering mothers, grandmothers, and children with knowledge and understanding, this initiative sought to create a culture of proactive healthcare engagement and encourage the uptake of routine immunization. Through community-driven efforts, Ladli Foundation endeavors to contribute to improved immunization rates and better health outcomes for all.



SENSITIZATION OF MAS

Team Ladli orchestrated significant meetings with active members of the MAS in Jaipur to emphasize the critical role of routine immunization in child health and the future well-being of our country. During these meetings, we urged MAS members to support routine immunization efforts and encouraged them to initiate action in their respective communities. The event served as a platform to galvanize grassroots support for routine immunization. To date, we have organized 43 MAS meetings and sensitized over 800 MAS members.



SENSITIZATION OF SHG

Team Ladli organized sensitization workshops and counseling sessions for Self Help Group (SHG) members in Jaipur and Chandigarh. These workshops aimed to raise awareness about the importance of immunization and its impact on the future health of the country. We encouraged SHG members to spread this knowledge within their networks and local areas, acting as supportive advocates for immunization. By orienting them on the benefits of vaccinations, we aimed to empower these members to actively contribute to the health and well-being of their communities. This initiative has fostered a grassroots movement, amplifying the reach and impact of our immunization efforts.

- Initiated Innovative Activities for community mobilization such as Samuhik God Bharai, Samuhik Kuan Poojan, Dadi - Dada Ki Duaaye & etc.
- Door to door IPC sessions and outreach sessions within the community
- Engaging frontline health workers, sarpanch, parents and multi-faith based gurus to spread awareness about RI.
- Support from other development partners and local NGOs for camp planning and mobilization
- Public announcements to increase awareness and help in information dissemination for the Routine Immunization in the community
- Mobilization of children from hard to reach areas/rural areas to nearest PHCs for vaccination
- Exclusively designed Nukkad Nataks and Ratri chaupals in High risk areas
- Fun and reward-based activities like dance, music, sports and painting competition to effectively engage students.
- To create sustainable awareness, a variety of sensitization workshops and interactive sessions were organized.

ACHIEVEMENTS

- The organization received appreciation letters from CMHO and RCHO of the district for the leadership and innovation in promoting routine immunization.
- Community Mobilization Activities by organizing Ratri Chaupal, showcasing folk dance, utilizing miking for effective communication
- Four Model Immunization Center was developed to promote the increase of Routine Immunization.
- The organization was successful in conducting a Routine Immunization events with the mass population by celebrating the special days in Rajasthan and Chandigarh.
- We could successfully enrolled 1100 teeka mitras under the social Internship programme. These teeka mitras assist the team in doing community awareness activities.
- The team with the local health department did micro-planning in all the which could help the health system to increase the mobilization of beneficiaries.

- Through the mothers and fathers meeting, organisation could reach to thousands of parents and sensitized them regarding the benefits of RI
- The innovation activity Dada-Dadi ki duayeingot included in the micro-plan.

CHALLENGES

- Parents are hesitant towards Routine Immunization of their children as there is a lot of misconception and misinformation towards vaccination.
- Certain religious, philosophical, or cultural beliefs conflict with the concept of vaccination.
- Insufficient knowledge about the benefits and importance of routine immunization has contributed to the low demand for vaccination.
- Due to elections, there were challenges to conduct mass awareness events in Rajasthan and Chandigarh
- Some minorities communities are hesitant to participate in immunization sessions.
